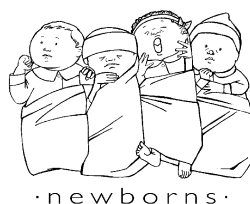

MCC is responding to the needs of Myanmar cyclone victims by working with trusted partner organizations. Often the quickest and most effective way to address emergency needs is through financially assisting partner organizations to purchase local resources. This removes the difficulty highlighted by the media attention of material aid not clearing customs or being controlled by the government and speeds critical response time.

MCC has committed \$100,000 to support initial relief efforts through partners who are providing water purification powder for clean water, food, medicine, blankets and other emergency supplies. MCC has committed an additional \$400,000 for longer-term recovery and rebuilding.
