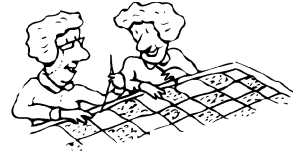
The MMA presentation on Stewardship for Children will be cancelled for today. Hopefully, we can reschedule sometime in the Fall when more people will be able to attend.
