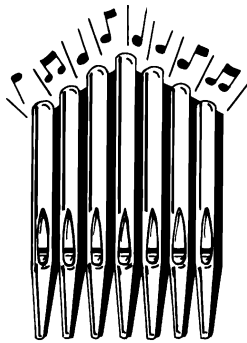

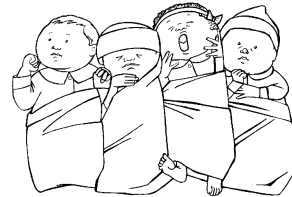
January 31 - Annual meeting carry-in lunch. Church will furnish beverage and table service only. More details will follow.


