From Women in Mission: Totals for sewn items listed in the Annual Report Book as being distributed in 2009 are 206 regular sized comforters, 25 small comforters, 12 regular quilts and 11 baby quilts. WIM's sewn items donated to the Ohio Relief Sale brought \$2590.00 and sewn items donated to the Texas Relief Sale brought \$4150.00 for a total of \$6740.00 that went to MCC.

In the January issue of the Reporter, found in each of your mailboxes, Salem is featured in an article on the front page about the bikes provided to Tanzania and also on page 3 about our Thanksgiving sale.

The Haiti Fund gift has grown to about \$3,400.00 from the \$2,500.00 seed money that was placed there after the January Board meeting. Let's increase that fund to at least double the seed money. We are distributing this through Mennonite Central Committee which has a very low administrative cost.

Thank you for your continued support of MCC's response to the earthquake in Haiti. Cans of meat, water filters, basic medical supplies and tarps are currently being distributed. Teams of structural engineers are assessing buildings, and staff are working in internally displaced persons camps registering people who have become homeless.
