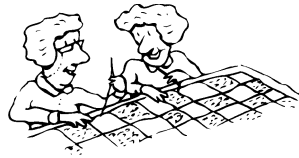

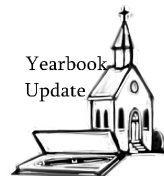
Today Lin & Pam Beyer - 12 Years!
